w^h the flax may be liable & accepted to till
such time as it is safely conveyed & delivered to me at
New York in terms of the sd Proct^r of the sd Company be liable
to him in the penalty y^e y^e sd Proct^r as they
have incurred a breach of the sd Proct^r of delivering to
him the q^{ty} of flax at the time & place y^e sd Proct^r
of all Charges & expences conform to the tenor
