my watch when he shall me from this mortall life to eternall happiness and rest, And to the effect ther may not arise any
debate or contraversie betwixt my wife and children nor be my children amongst themselves after my decease Doemyn
my testament and last will as follows In the first place Doe recommend my soule to god the creator and hope
to be saved through the merits and purchase of my blessed Lord and saviour Jesus Christ my redeemer And for dame
my Spouse quicke that please god to make her adñe to be interred in one Christian manner And next I appoynt Margaret
Hale my spouse to be my sole and only executrix and universall Intromissatrix with my full moves goods gear somes
Cattle horse holt sheep gold silver sonced and uncoyned Insignt plentishe dwincles and Domicile debt and summe
of money resland awand and adolede to me by whatfor persone or persones by bond obligacione lequit at my
bokes obligatory missive letter assignacione or any other maner of way whatfor which shall be pertaininge and resting to me
the tyme of my decease Dispensing with the generality hereof and admitting ther presents to be alswise valid effectual
and sufficient as if every particular movele perteining to me or debts resting or that shall be resting to me therfore
my decease wold haue particularly intent and ingredit with the notwithstanding wherof I have dispensed and a same
for ever. With full power to my said spouse (if need be) to give up Inventur therof and to sell all respects as any
in Testamente and to call and pursue therfor as awards of the lawe and to doe all things appoynt my said spouse and
other executrix or universall intromissatrix by the lawes of the Kingdome may doe And all almes of money after myt and that
executrix and sole Intromissatrix to sacrifice and pay to my children and erwryt under setting to me the by me of my decease
out of the first end of my said moves and debts that shall be left after my second daughter the summe of
Imprimes I appoynt my said spouse to content & pay to my selfe to content pay and deliver to Margaret Hale my
Eight hundred markes boþ money Item I appoynt my hundred markes mony forde and appoynt my said spouse to pay
youngest Daule daughter the lesse summe of other eys after their marriage or after their attaininge to the yere
the foraid Legaries to them and that I med. after their marriage or after their attaininge to the yere
of twentie one years compleat, With the provisone that in daies James Hale my second daughter to whom I have
granted a disposition of my her Lands of the daie of this present and redemeable by Robert Hale my eldest
Daule sonne in manner and more fully therinment By which disposition the said James standt bound and obldged
that how soevre he lave me of two thousand markes boþ money shall be payed to him or consigned for his use and
behroves by his said brother and that for redemyng of the foraid Lands he shal content þy and deliver
to the said Hale and Margaret Hale the one half therof equall betwixt hem, and my said spouse shall be in
that sume only bound for the sume of six hundred markes to my daule named But in lase the sume Lands shall
be evicted by any of the said Robert Hale his creditor or any persone whatfor to whom he has granted or may grant
right therof without payment or consignature of the said sume then and in that lase the said James is to be free and
bound a ment and the sume allenerly to be payed by my said spouse in manner foraid my said children
payement therof being herby allways obldged to grant ane ample sufficient and valde discharge to my said spouse
sonne and our foraides of all barnes paull of gear or portione naturall q̄k̄ they can by any wayes ask crav or claime
of us after our deceases any maner of way off or on the sume at the pleasure of god (It shall happen) And Likewise my said
spouse is herby bound and obldged to matame interlaine and furthfist my said daughters in bed and board and to
putt them to schools of learning otherwise any of my friends who shall take them and putt them to the school and
Iutlaine and matelaine them in mannerforde shall have the rent of the said portions and estimacione yearly appoynted
to be payed in mannerforde Saule and & Iesu Christ and allwayes to me my owen lyfesent right of the said premises
During all the dayes of my lyfylme and this my testament and latter will I make knowne to all and sundry
whom it effecteth Declairing Likewise that in lase any of my friends shall take my daughters and mantaine and
cause edurate them in mannerforde and bestow upon them Cloathes to them suitable to their degree and qualite my
said spouse is herby obldged to remorte and pay for their Cloathing alſo well as for their mantinance and education
And heireys successors and heires all former testaments and latter wills made before by me in lase any be
And declare that this present shall stand uncontroled or morayt me in all tyme coming at my last latterwill and
testament and shall doe nothing burft or prejudiciale heirens In testimonie q̄oƿ prwitten by George Traill
writter in Kortell for James Mansone noوارþt yr I have full this present At the Cittie of Ireland the tenth day of July
