 uncertaint then the hour thereof, And being most willing to dispose upon and sell all my worldly affairs and to be free of the
 Burden and trouble of the same To the effect I may sell and give my heart and thoughts upon my Redeemer and may be upon
 my watch when he calls me from this mortall life to eternall happiness and Rest, And to the effect ther may not arise any
 Debate or Contraversee Betwixt my wife and children nor to my children amongst themselves after my Decease I doe make
 my Testament and Latter will as follows **In the first place** I doe recomend my soule to God the Creator and hope
 to be saved through the merits and purchast of my blessed Lord and Saviour **Jesus Christ** my Redeemer And I ordaine
 my body to be buried in such place as shall please God to make Sepulchre to be Interred in one Christian manner And that I appoynt **Margaret**
Halcro my spouse to be my sole and only executrix and universall Intromittrix with my hable movell goods gear some
 Cattle horse noll sheep Gold Silver Jewels and uncoined Insight plenishing outwells and Domicill Debt and some
 of money - restand arownd and adbled to me by whatfor persone or persones by bond obligacion legitt acrompt Deed some
 bock obligatory missive letter assignacion or any other manner of way whatfor which shall be pertaining and resting to me
 the tyme of my Decease Dispenning with the Generality thereof and admittiny ther presents to be also valied off extrow
 and sufficient as if every particular movell part came to me or debts resting or that shall be resting to me the tyme
 my Decease were herein partarly insert and Ingroed with the not Doeing wherof I have Dispened and a some
 for ever. **With full power** to my said spouse (if need be) to give up Inveniar therof and to for all respects as any
 in Testament and to call and persue therfor as avords of the Law and to doe all things appoynt my said spouse and
 other executrix or universall Intromittatrix by the Lawes of the Kingdome may doe And a shomes of money afterment and that
 executrix and sole Intromittatrix to satisfie and pay to my children and erwyt and resting to me the tyme of my Decease
 out of the first end of my saids movells and debts that shall be pertalero my second **Tull** Daughter the somme of
Imprimis I appoynt my said spouse to content & pay to **Katharine** to content pay and deliver to **Margret Halcro** my
Eight Hundred marks scots money Item I appoynt my youngest **Tull** Daughter the like somme of other ev
 hundred marks money And appoynt my said spouse to pay
 the foraid Legacies to them and that **Imprimis** after their Expire Marriages or after their attaining to the age
 of twentie one years (except, with this proviso that in case James Halcro my second Tull son to whom I have
 Granted a Disposicione of my said Lands of the Dale of their presents and Redeimable by **Robert Halcro** my eldest
 Tull son in manner and more fully therein ment By which Disposicione the said James stand bound and obliged
 that how soever the somme of two thousand marks scots money shall be payed to him or assigned for his use and
 behoove by his said Brother and that for Redeiminy of the foraid Lands he shall content pay and deliver
 to the said **Katharine** and **Margaret Halcro** ^{my Daughters} the one half therof equidly Betwixt them, and my said spouse shall be in
 that case only bound for the somme of five hundred marks to my Daughters named **Prit** in case the samen Lands shall
 be evicted by any of the said **Robert Halcro** his Creditors or any persone whatfor to whom he has granted or may grant
 right therof without payment or assignacion of the said somme then and in that case the said James is to be bound
 to the said **Katharine** and **Margaret Halcro** and the samen allenerly to be payed by my said spouse in manner foraid My said children
 named upon payment therof being hereby allwayes obliged to grant an ample sufficient and valied discharge to my said spouse
 and our foraid of all barres part of gear or portione naturall gfts they (an any wayes aske crave or claime
 of us after our Deceases any manner of way qfor on the samen at the pleasure of ^{God} shall happen) And Likewise my said
 spouse is hereby bound and obliged to maintain and furnish my said Daughters in bed and board and to
 putt them to schools of Learning otherwise any of my friends who shall take them and putt them to school and
 Intermaine and maintain them in manner foraid shall have the rent of the said portione and Estimacion yearly appoynted
 to be payed in manner foraid **Sause and Reserve** and allwayes to me my owen lyfesent right of the hable promiss
 I amny all the Dayes of my lyf tyme) and this my Testament and Latter will I make known to all and sundry
 whom it effects (Declairiny Likewise that in case any of my friends shall take my Daughters and maintain and
 cause educate them in manner foraid and bestow upon them Cloathng to them suitable to their Degree and quality my
 said spouse is hereby obliged to reimburse and pay for their Cloathng also well as for their maintenance and education)
 And hereby revoke and Recalls all former Testaments and Latter wills made of befor by me (in case any be)
 And declair that ther presents shall stand unrevoked or movably me in all tyme coming as my last Latter will and
 Testament and shall doe nothing hurtfull or prejudiciall therunto In Testimonie qfor (written by **George Fraile**
 writer in **Hertford** for **James Mansone** notary publick) I have full this presents At the shire of **Ireland** the tenth day of July
 One thousand seven hundred and sixty six Before their witness **Edward Coult** of **Clunby** **Thomas Coult** his Tull son the
James Mansone and **George Fraile** receive (deseyned with **John Pitt** currie minister of the gospel at **Kirk and Stone**
 for Substantiar) **Thomas Coult** Ed: Coult witness **Th: Coult** witness **J: Mansone** witness **Geo: Fraile**
 witness **J: Mansone** witness.
