July 13th 1810

My dear Robert.

I received your letter but
a day back - you astonish me, when you tell me
that Mr. Dixon denies having received the Water
Chain Seals &c from me - I have his receipt for
it - a Copy of which is here attested by a further
specimen of ours - when I first got your water it -
was as I have before often told you from Mrs
Gobbers for which I paid 10/6 - this Mr Dixon
repaid me and I gave her up the Water &c
together with your address - on the 15th Aug^r 1806 -
Two years since, and not having heard from
you since, I made sure you had received it
However it is a great pleasure to me that I have
his receipt and had a friend with me when
he received it - you ask me for Fells address
I have not heard from him or any of the Ma-
-daughters these two years - the last letter I had
from Fells was from Hardstone Jail: where he
was a Prisoner; I give you every joy on your
marriage, I myself have been married a little
more than a year & a half, and have had one -

did a Boy - Still Nora = you of course knew of
how Betty Rowden death in America cutting
out = I have frequent letters from Capt. Mearns
he has no idea of being employed at present
he has built a noble - Chapel on his Estate -
which will contain near 500 - Persons -
I shall write to Mr. Dixon if I do not go to
him myself - immediately - so you need not
address to me here as I shall probably be
at Port. & by the time you receive this =
or when I hear any tidings of it - I will im-
mediately enquire either you or Mr. Knande
Mr. Dixon is acting the part of a great
Rascal - by you, and be assured as he has
made me feel rather uncomfortable, I will
talk to him sharply = this just receipt -
is from the wife of the watchmaker, who
died a few days after my arrival in England
for the money I was obliged to pay before -
I could get it from her - With best respects
to Mrs. R. - Believe me Dear Robertson
