That your Petitioners respectively
stand in feft in the lands as per mentioned
with the pertinents theriof belonging to
them in the Town of Bullerton in the Parish
of Stromness viz the said Robert Graham in
one penny land in Oraken the said James
Jung in one penny land there and the said
John Sinclair in five feathers land in
one acre there and consequently have good
and undoubted right to a proportional
share of the whole privileges and
pertinents of the said town and particu-
larly and especially of the help shores
thereof and the help or others made of
the Tange that would growne or lymne
upon the said shores and that referring
to said share of the said town yet
your said Petitioners for these several years
bygone have been most wrongously
and unjustly deprived of their said share
of the help made upon the said
shores or of any acknowledgment on
that account and that by Robert Graham
of Oraken his Factors men and others who
have hitherto made the Tange of the said
whole shores into help the said Robert
Graham of Oraken being possessed
of thirty one penny land & one half penny
land

land of the said Towne and consequently
proceede & as if were in proportion only
to his lands in the said town and ought
to account for and pay to your said
Petitioners respectively any sum or
sums of money arising from time to time
from the said Keep & farms to their said
Shares of the whole town which coult
of their respective land in whole and
tho your Petitioners have of a diverse
times desired the said Brethren to make
just account and payment to your petiti
oners accordingly yet he wrongfully
refuset to do and intend to carry
away another wayt & upon the
Keep & farms and lynes upon the
said Shares of Bullertown without making
any satisfaction to your Petitioners
unless compelled

May it therefore please your hon
to grant warrant for arreapning
the said Keep & farms lynes upon
Shares of Bullertown until your
Petitioners are satisfied as to their
Shares of the said town and the said
Brethren liable thereto and to
satisfy and pay your petitioners
any sum or sums in proportion to
their share of the Keep & farms and
disposed upon by him upon the
said Shares at any time bygone
according to Justice
