

Stromness January the 23rd 1798.

As we have sett'd accounts with you this day
concerning the few hundred marks Scots money
provided payable to me Mary Halero in a disposition
dated the thirtieth day of March one thousand
seven hundred fifty eight by my father to my brother
& formed to a filled account of this debt satisfied and
paid us the said principle sum and interest therof
due at merlesay last we her by obliges to grant you
as letes and Caration to William Halero of Couberdon
a sufficient discharge upon Stamp paper of the said
& also within a reasonable time when required and also
to indemnify you of the Rent of that part of the
room and lands of Couberdon provided to me the
said Mary Halero by my said brother Hugh
Halero by a will under his hand in our first
act and of that for all years and terms possess
by us possessing the farm of Halamef one thou
ousand seven hundred and Seventy five for which
wee have not accounted to you and also wee oblige
us to sit and remove from the said room and lands
and leave it you at the term of martines next
to com without any warning or process of Law so
that you may freely let or dispose of it against
that term as you think proper and wee ob
lige ~~us~~ to make the said writt forth coming
or an extract of it to you or any other Cons
erned as witnesses our hands daye & date above
written & wee are your friends William James
