Dear Sir

I am in advance to Messrs Tod & Willms  
the Agents in the Division of the Community of  
Aspin for the proportion of the Expenses which  
falls on your Estate of Bombeishi. The Lands  
receiving the benefit of the Division are liable  
to their share of the Expenses, if they had now  
come into possession of a singular Successor,  
and as you state them as fit of Detail appro-  
priating the Division by drawing the subse-  
quent Banks, it is not likely that Messrs Tod  
& Willms, of Tupton will demand from you for payment of  
this item in their account, until receipt of  
less than the principal sum £129. 3. 5 and  
the legal interest. I could not as proposed  
by your Agent Mr. Ward Bain in his letter  
of 10 instant take it upon me to accept of a  
composition in lieu of this claim; as properly  
the claim is theirs as Agents for the Parties  
in the Division and it belongs to them to  
liquidate it. They will no doubt consider  
that any person by whatever title he  
accords to the lands, has approved  
the claim of the said unsubmitted with  
the lands of the lands subsequent to the  
Division of the community. If you have

any proposal however to make for the  
settlement of their claim I shall transmit  
it to them - and shall be glad to hear from  
you with your earliest convenience as re-  
garding some demands which they at the time  
I shall have to offer them to you for the  
payment of this amount and have it trans-  
ferred to your credit with them from
