 Liquidate expence in case of failing in due payment
 With the due and ordinary Annual rent of the said
 principal sum from and after the said requestion
 or time of making payment of the said principal
 yearly Term by and proportionally, Whereafter during
 the whole payment thereof consenting to the Regis-
 tration hereof in the Books of Council & Session
 or others competent that Letters of Horning in due
 form and other Executorial necessary pass hereon
 on thirty days charge as aforesaid and thereto Consulate
