thers concerned of the said Sum of Eighteen pound
ten shillings Sterling money for now and ever
binding us Conjunctly and Severally our heirs
and Successors Conjunctly and Severally Forward
this our Discharge to the said John Crafts and
Capt. Squirell and their fore said at all have
witness whereof We ha herunto sett our
and Seals At Stronness in Orkney the therty
day of May One thousand Seven hundred and
eight years
