annuity being £249. 19. 6 Making Two hundred and nineteen
pounds 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ Making your Brother James thinks advisable
to keep in our hands allowing her Six p Cent per Annum Colony
Interest, untill we receive her own orders for the disposal thereof.

What monies belonging to the Estate are in your hands or in
the hands of Mrs Johnston we doubt not you will amicably
settle between yourselves, as we have no further knowledge of it
than you mentioned to your Brother last year.

To any trouble we have been at, in settling the Estate your
Daughter Catherine is extremely welcome. We remain
